In FY 20/21, Colorado collected \$426.3M in marijuana tax revenue. The revenue was divided as follows:



\$203M (47.6%)

See how the Cash Fund is used was credited to the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund and made available for appropriation for a variety of purposes.

\$153.6M* (36%)

was allocated to three funds that support K-12 education, including \$120.8 million in excise taxes and \$32.9 million originating as special sales taxes.

\$40.6M (9.5%)

was distributed to local governments that allow retail sales.

\$29M (6.8%)

was retained in the General Fund.
